Be in touch to get demo on lighting the propane heating stove – it's easy.

There's no electricity so bring a flashlight at night. There are a few little battery lights there. **Candles only in votives, please.**

Cozy wraps are in the cupboard.

Broom and dustpan are beside the cupboard as well as the hook to open the dome for ventilation. Please take care opening/shutting the dome. Read the instructions on the hook. When closing, don't over tighten!
